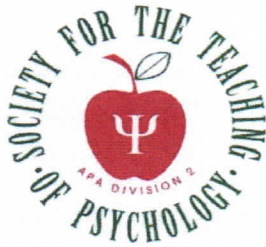

### **Call to Order and Welcome by Bill Addison, STP President**
